Methodology

- * Each council member receives a point if they voted in accordance with ANC's position. Major votes (e.g. lobbying transparency) receive three points.
- * The points are then divided by the total points possible for each issue to get a score.
- * A vote can count toward more than one issue.
- * The total score is the average of all scores for issue areas.
- * Issue areas are described in greater detail on the following page.
