Overall, down 6% compared to 2017

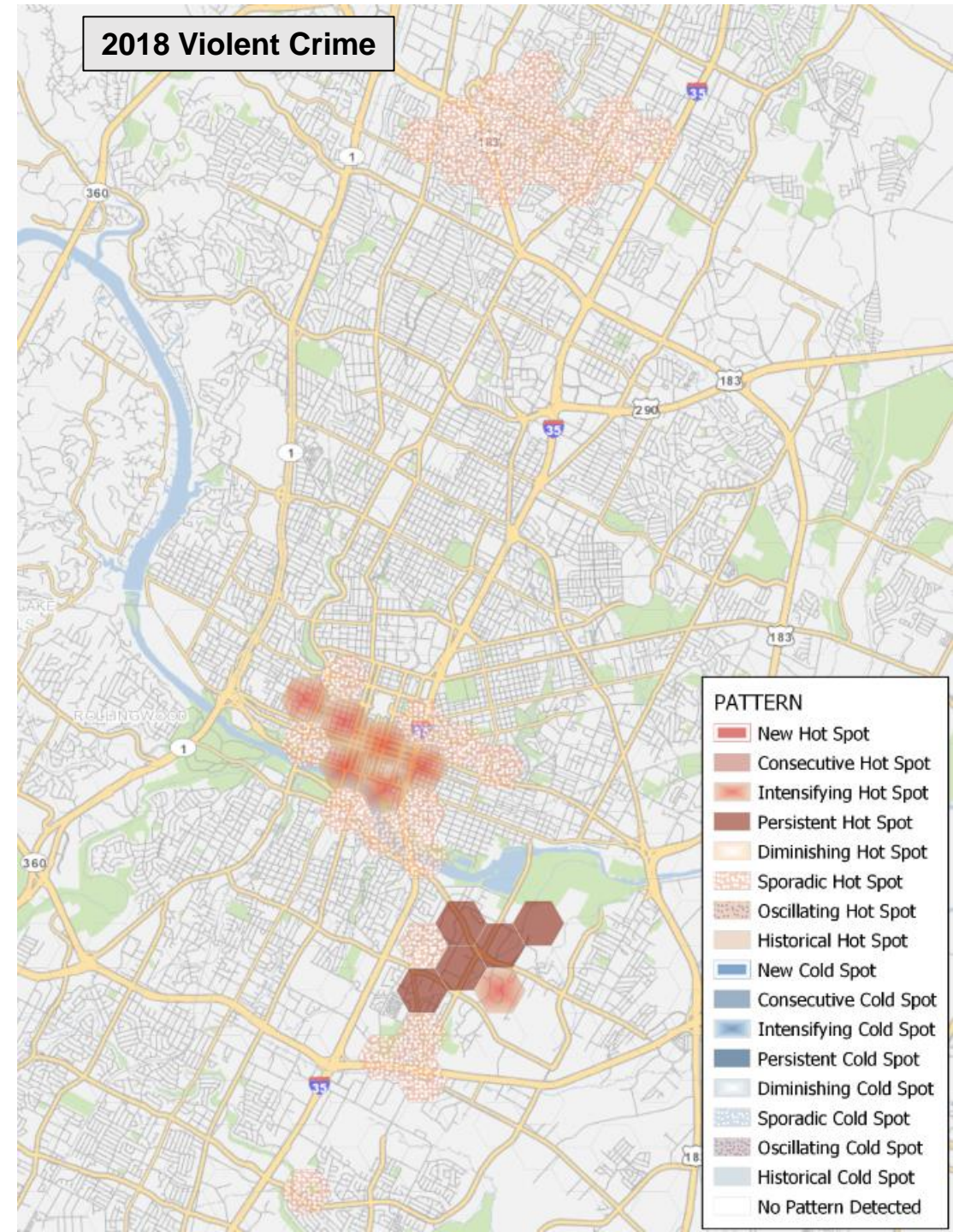
2017 Violent Crime Incidents: 4082

- 14 of 25 bank robberies were series-related

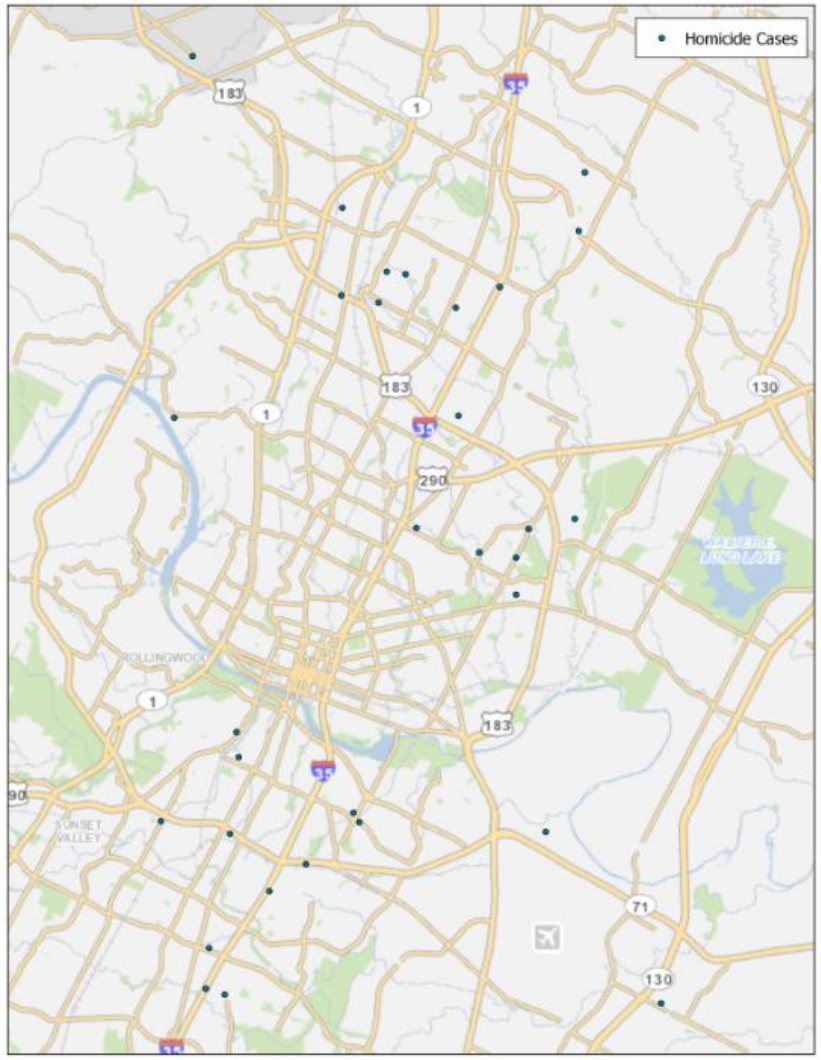




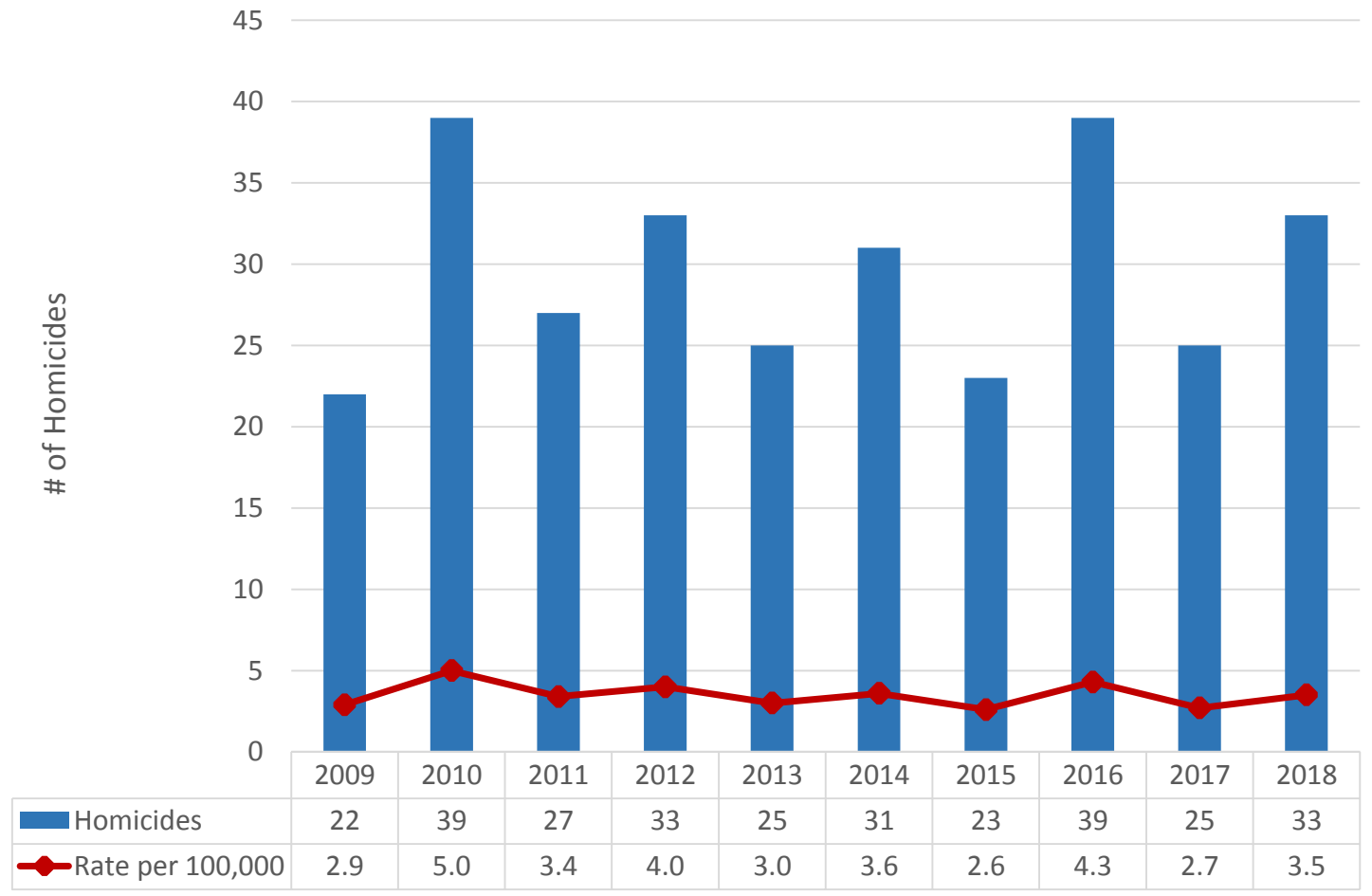
Historical Homicide Rates and 2018 Locations



2018 Homicide Locations

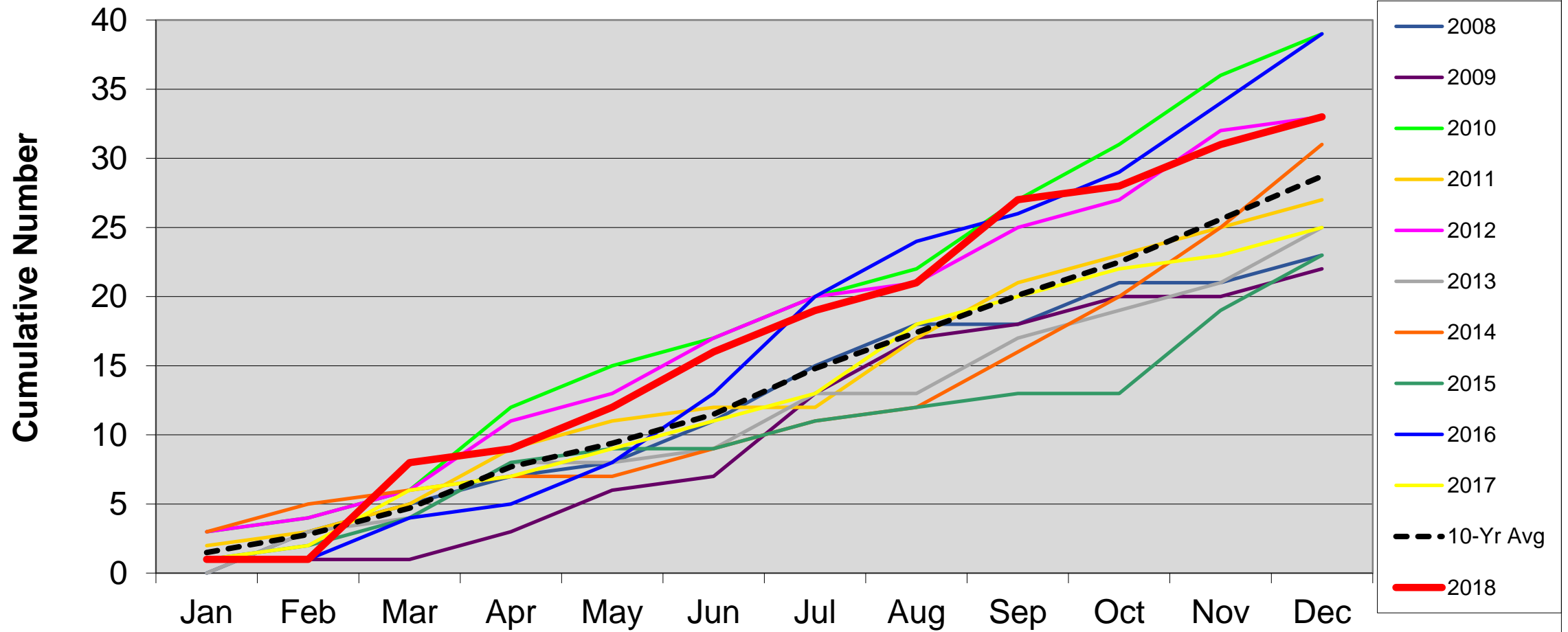


Homicides 2009-2018

 Two suspects responsible for multiple murders

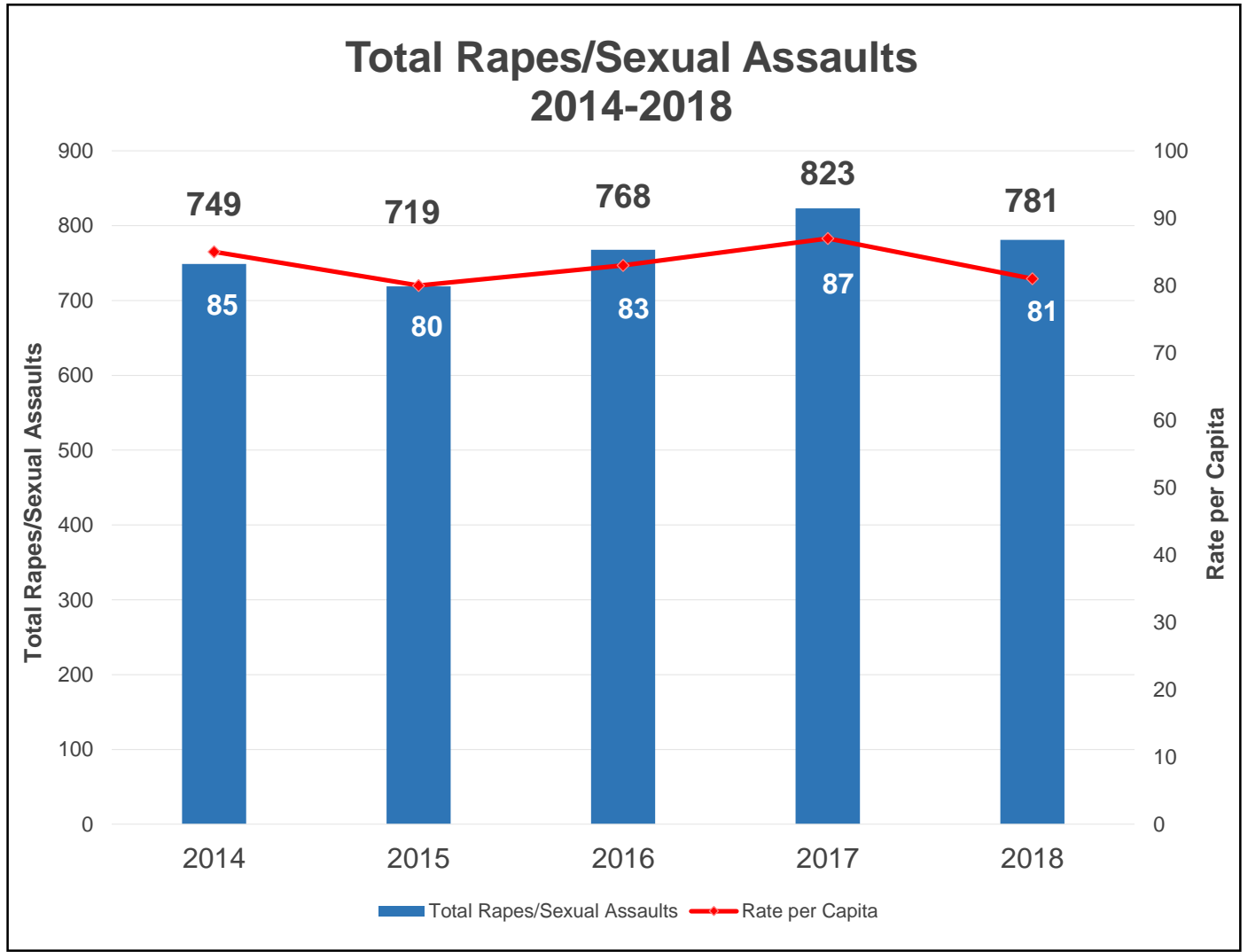
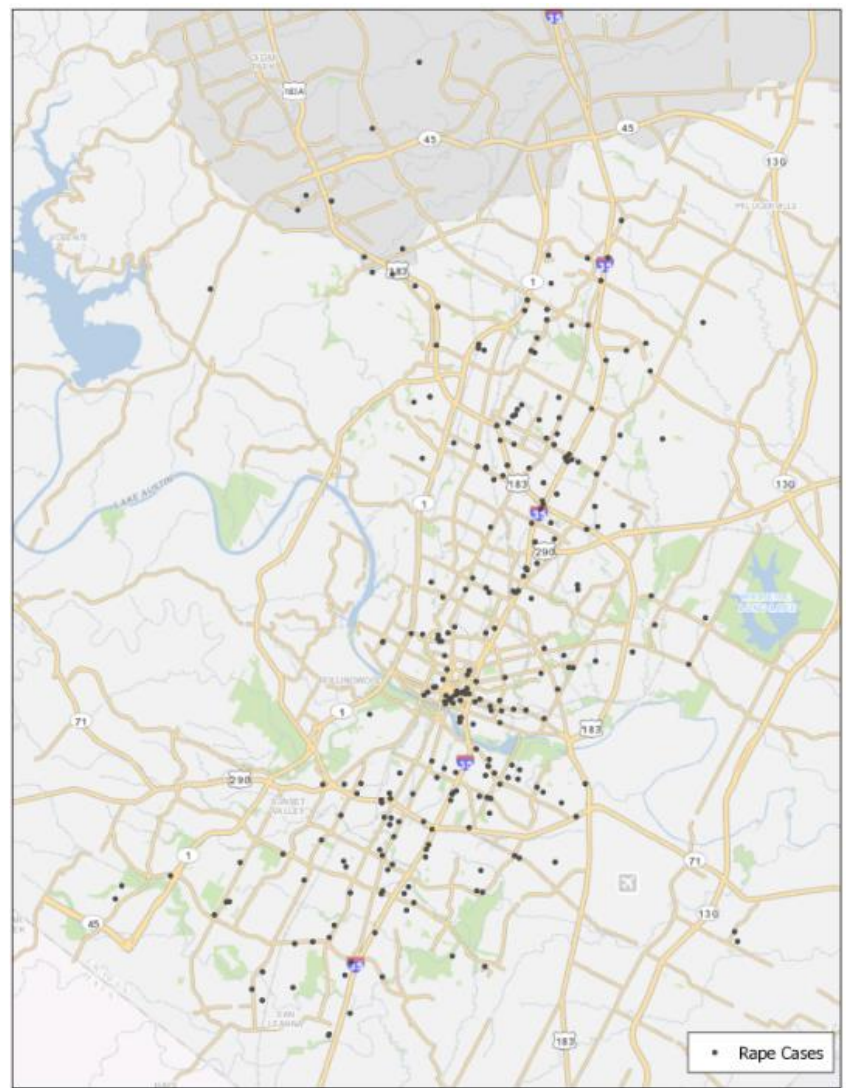

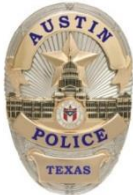


Historical Rape/Sex Assault Rates and 2018 Locations



2018 Reported Rape/SA Locations (781)

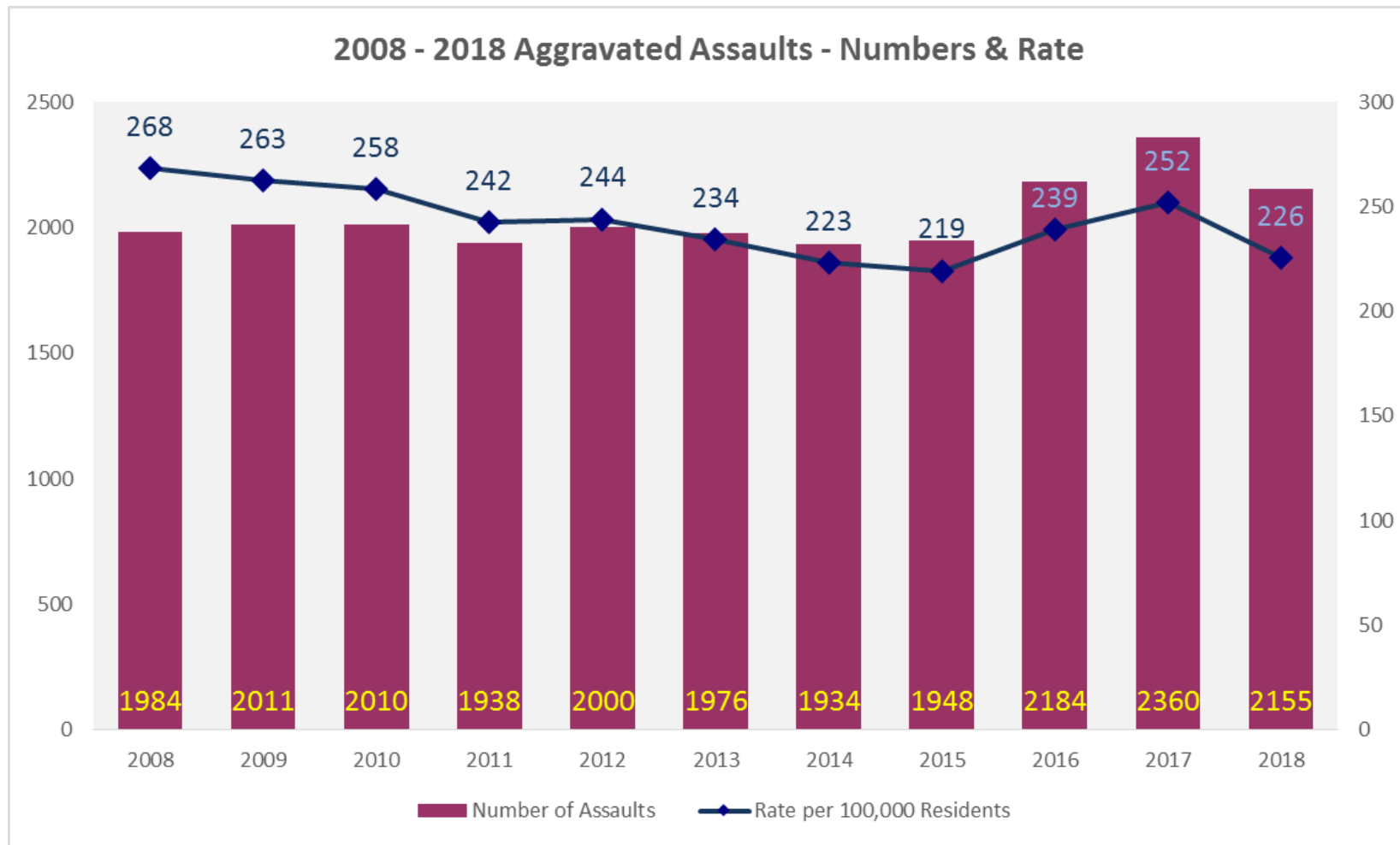
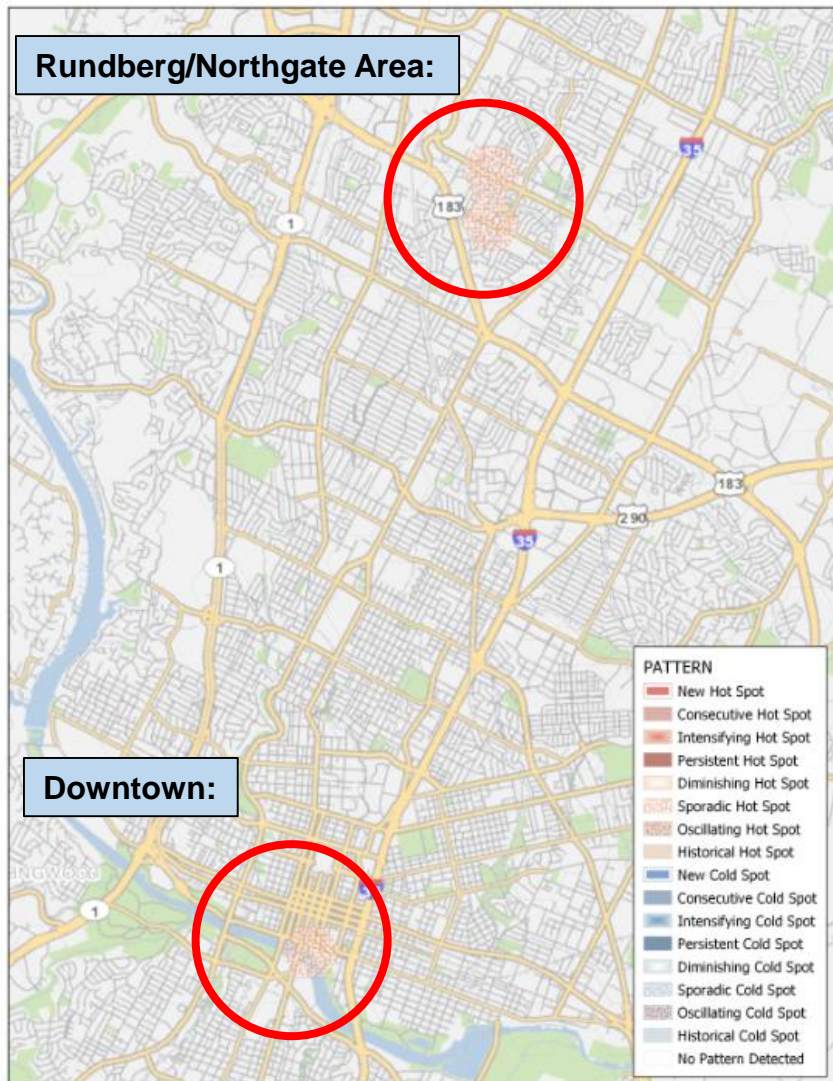




Historical Aggravated Assault Rates and 2018 Locations

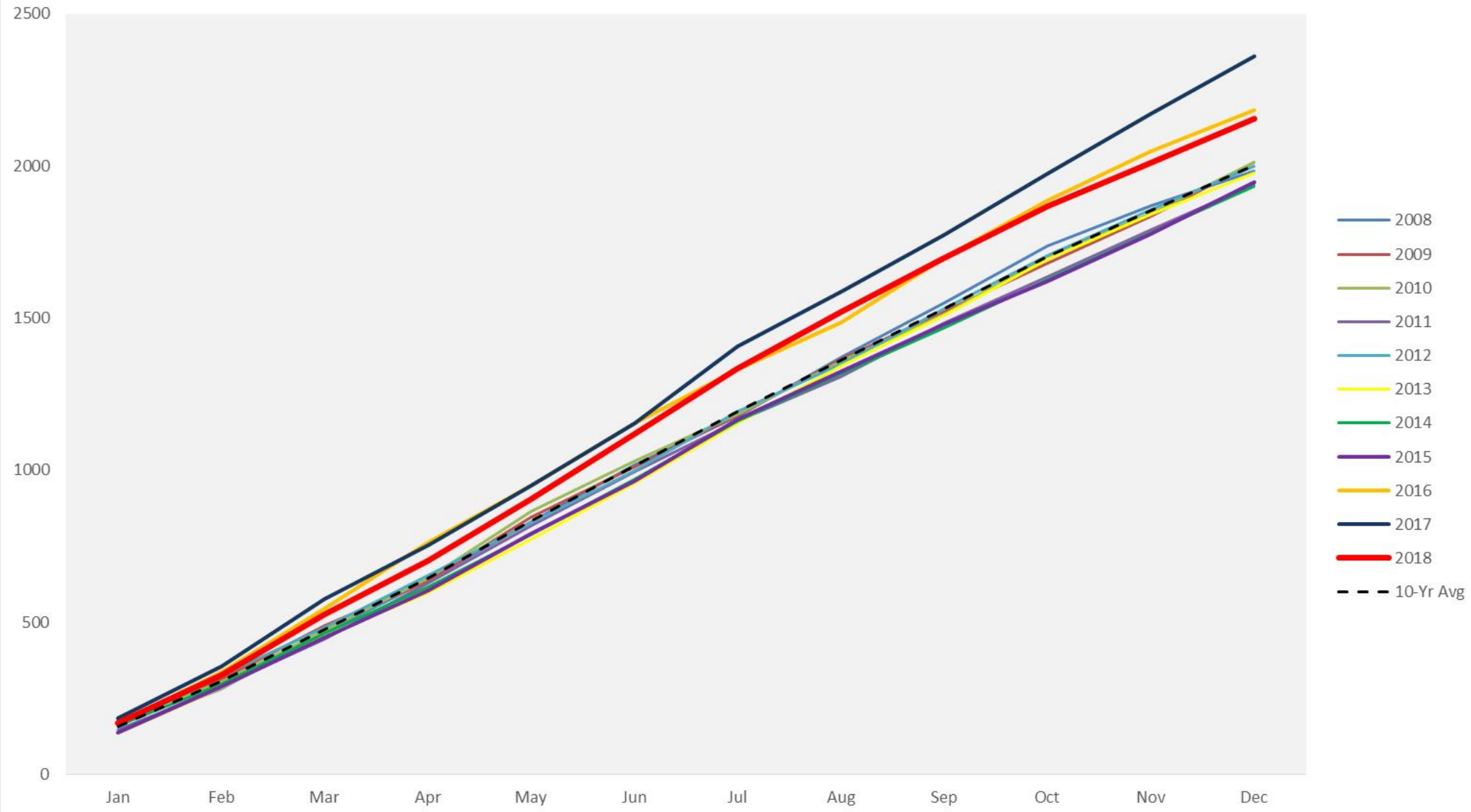


2018 Aggravated Assault Hot Spots (2155)



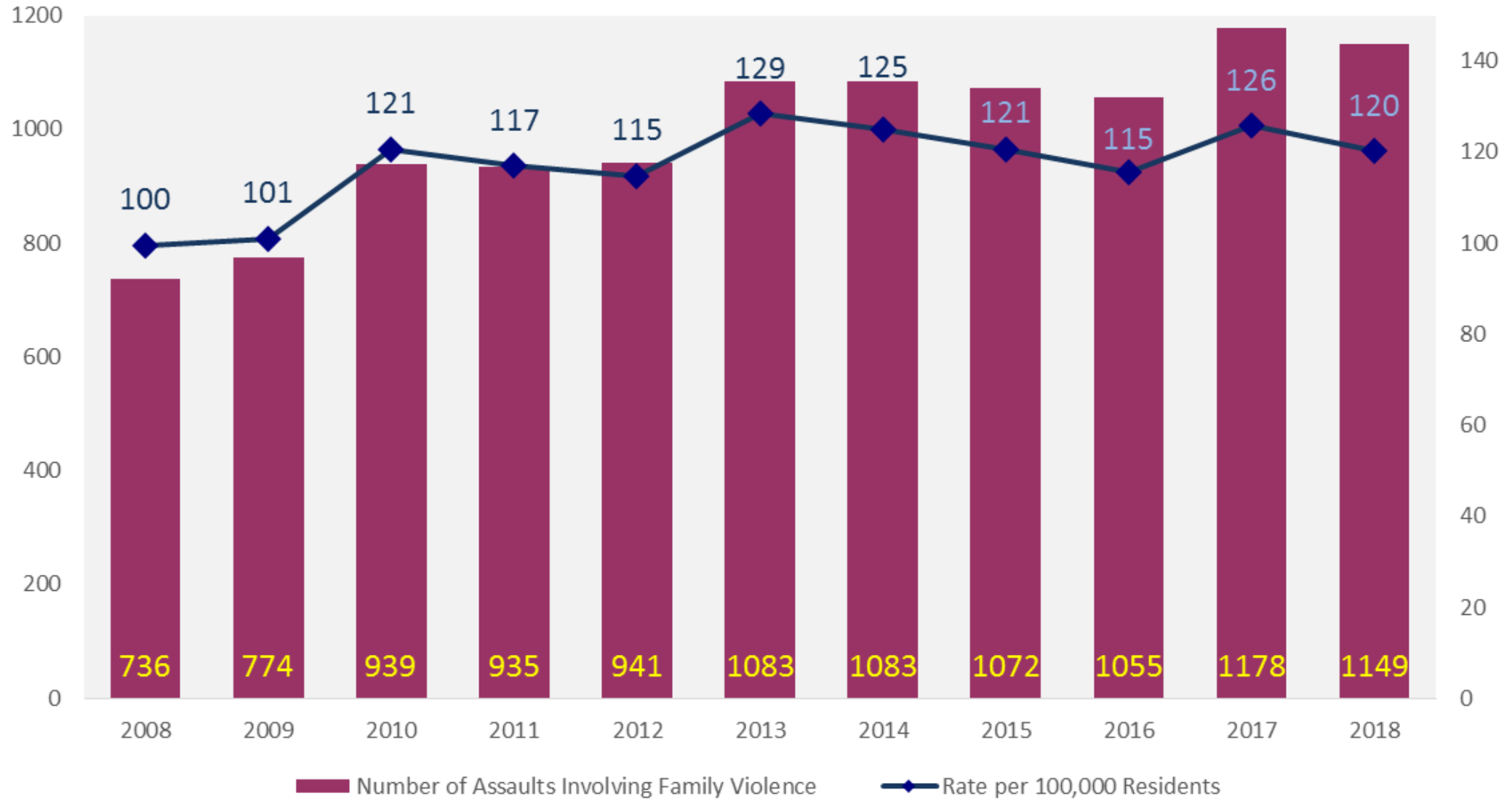


2008 - 2018 Aggravated Assault - Cumulative by Month



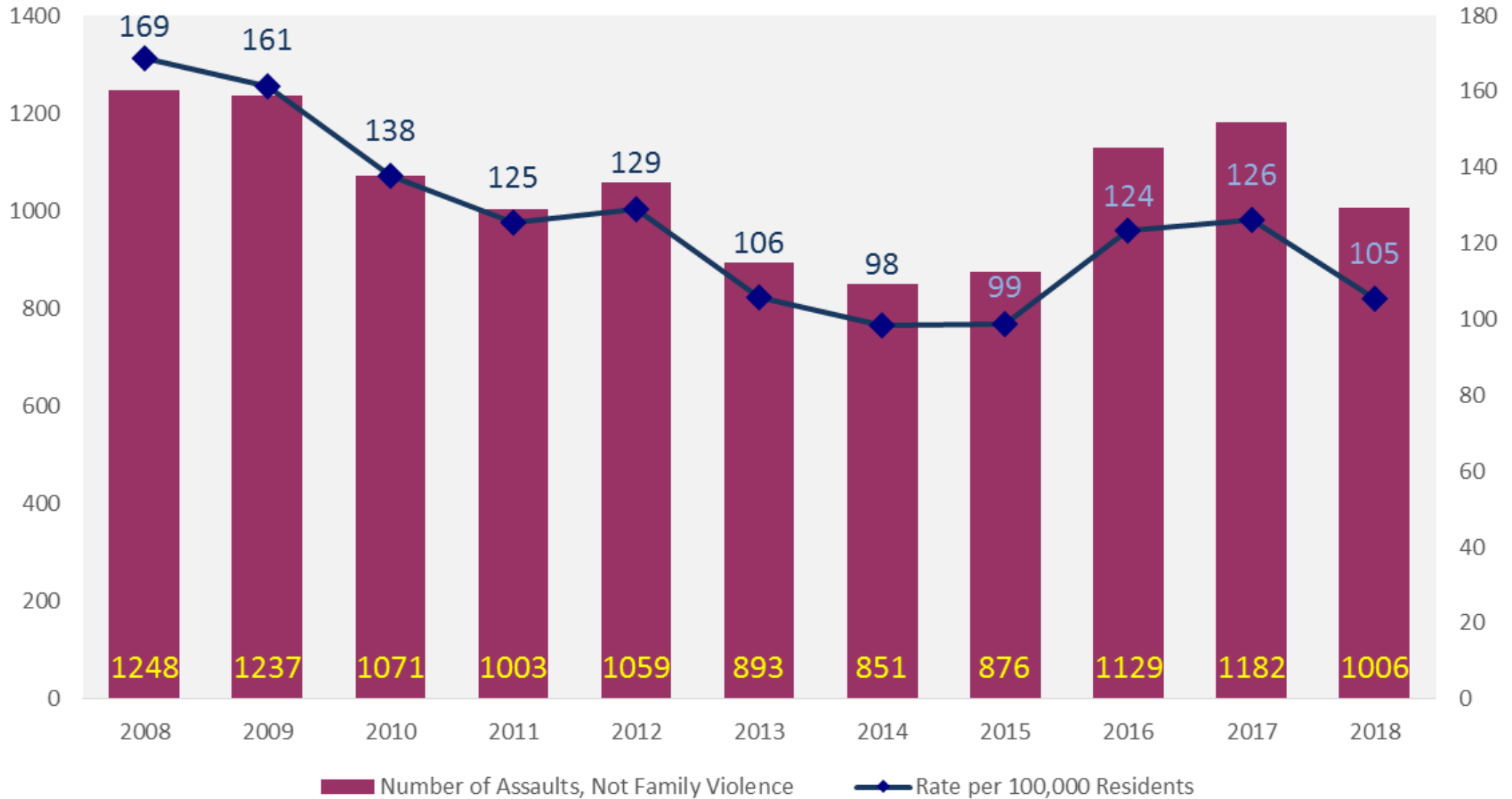


2008 - 2018 Family Violence Aggravated Assaults - Numbers & Rate



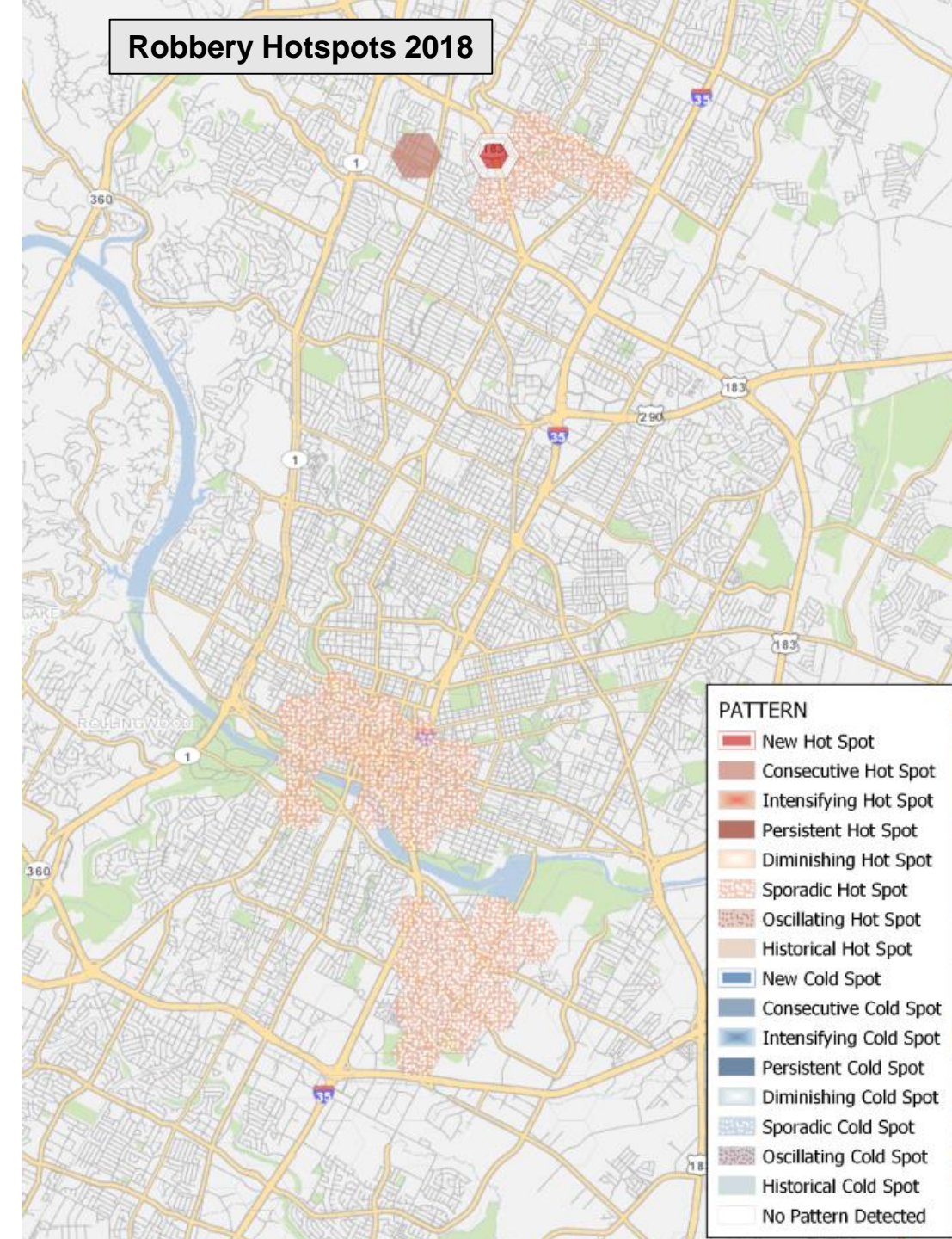


2008 - 2018 Aggravated Assaults (NOT Family Violence) - Numbers & Rate



2018 All Robberies:

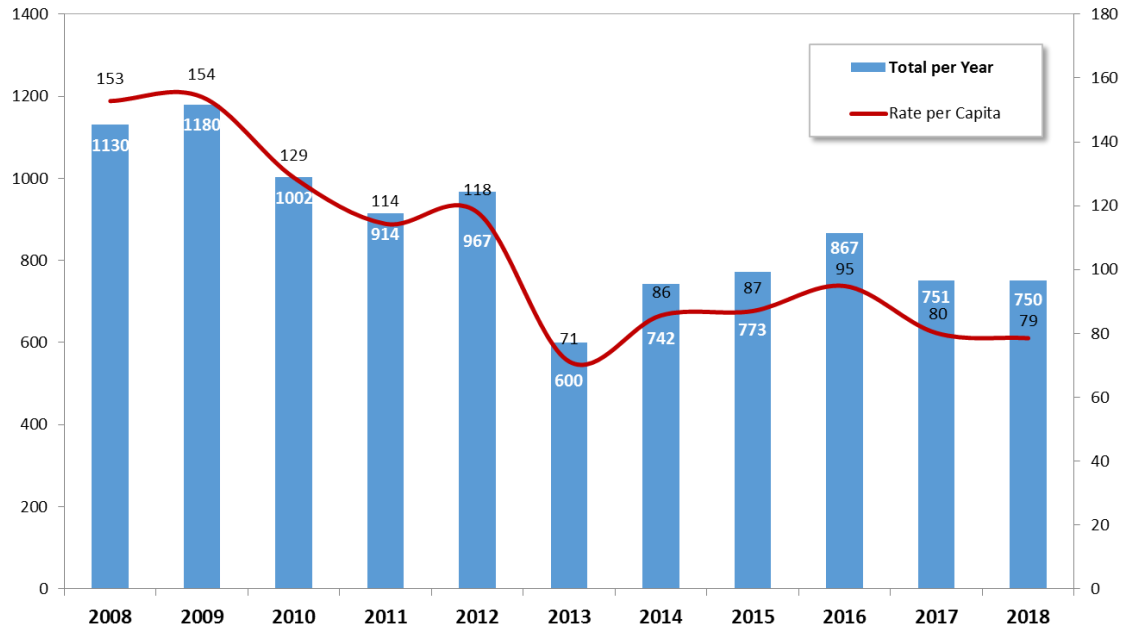
- **Bank Robberies**
 - Up to 25 from 18 in 2017
 - 19 of the 25 bank robberies have been cleared by arrest
 - 5-year average = 14
 - Normal range = 10 to 18
 - 2018 ended 38.9% above the normal range
- **Business Robberies**
 - Up to 246 from 219 in 2017
 - 5-year average = 167
 - Normal range = 136 to 198
 - 2018 ended 24.2% above normal range
- **Individual Robberies**
 - Down to 750 from 751 in 2017
 - 5-year average = 744
 - Normal range = 658 to 829
- **All Robberies**
 - Up to 1021 from 988 in 2017
 - 5-year average = 924
 - Normal range = 824 to 1025





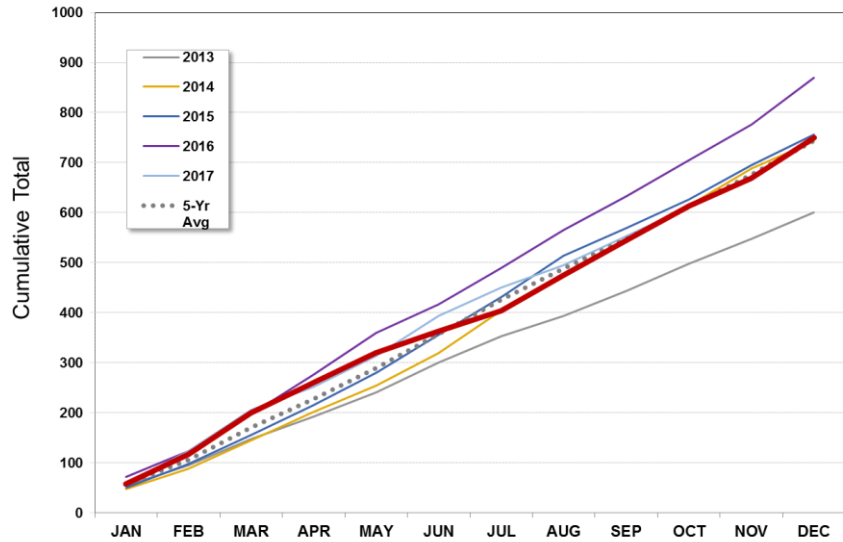
Individual Robberies 2008-2018

Total per Year & Rate per Capita



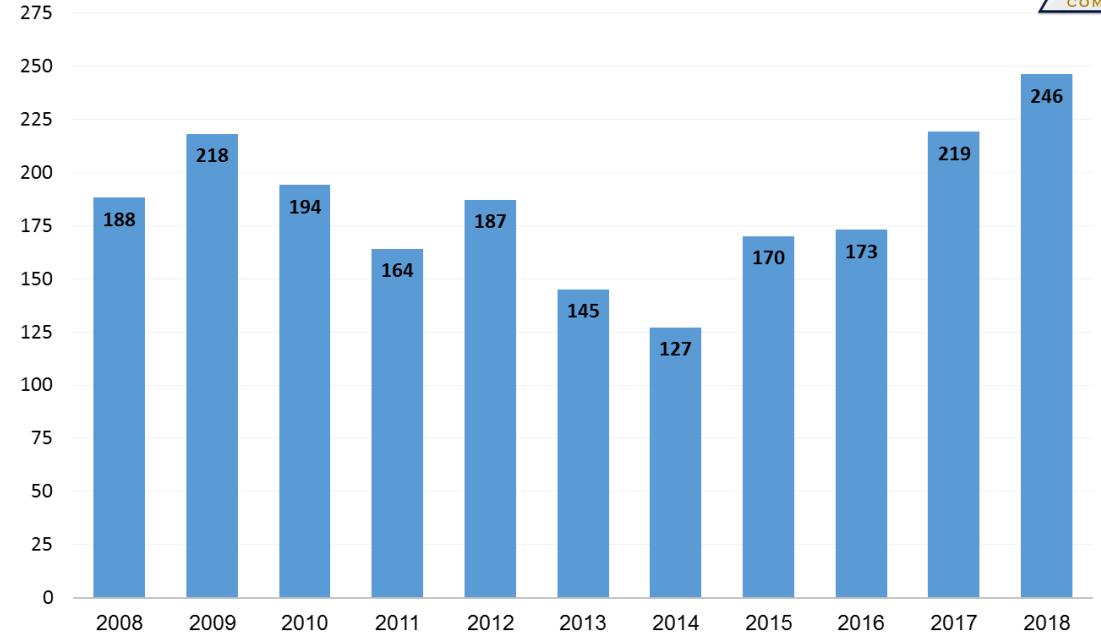
Citywide Individual Robberies 2013-2018

Cumulative Monthly Totals



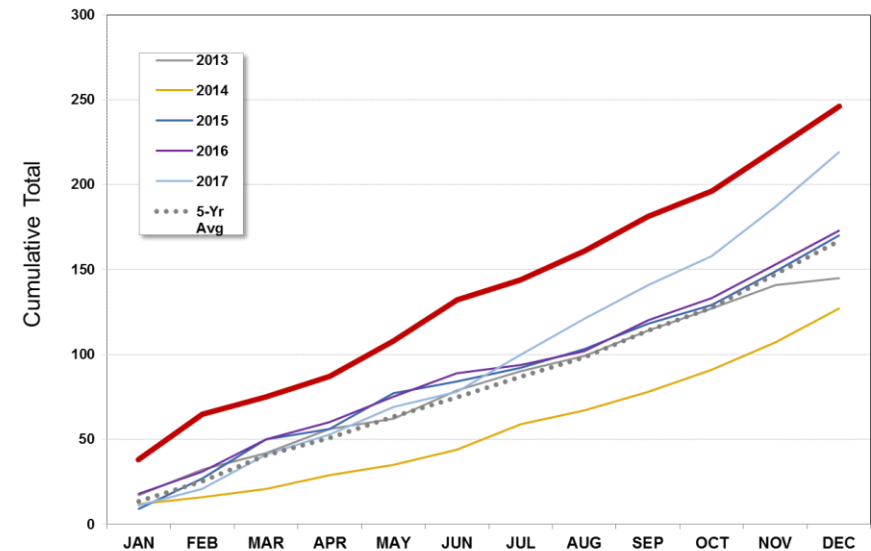
Business Robberies 2008-2018

Citywide Business Robberies 2013-2018

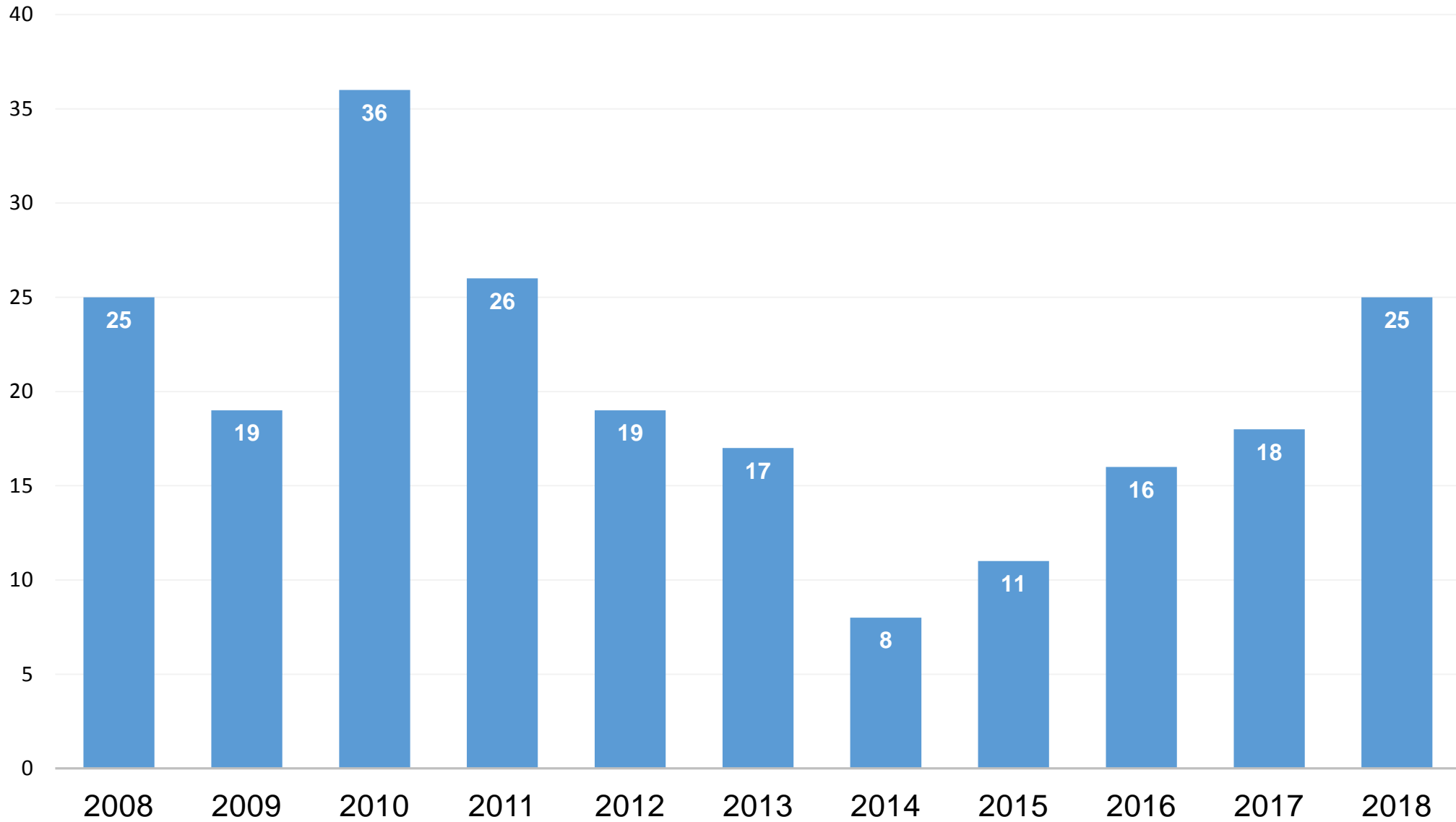
Cumulative Monthly Totals

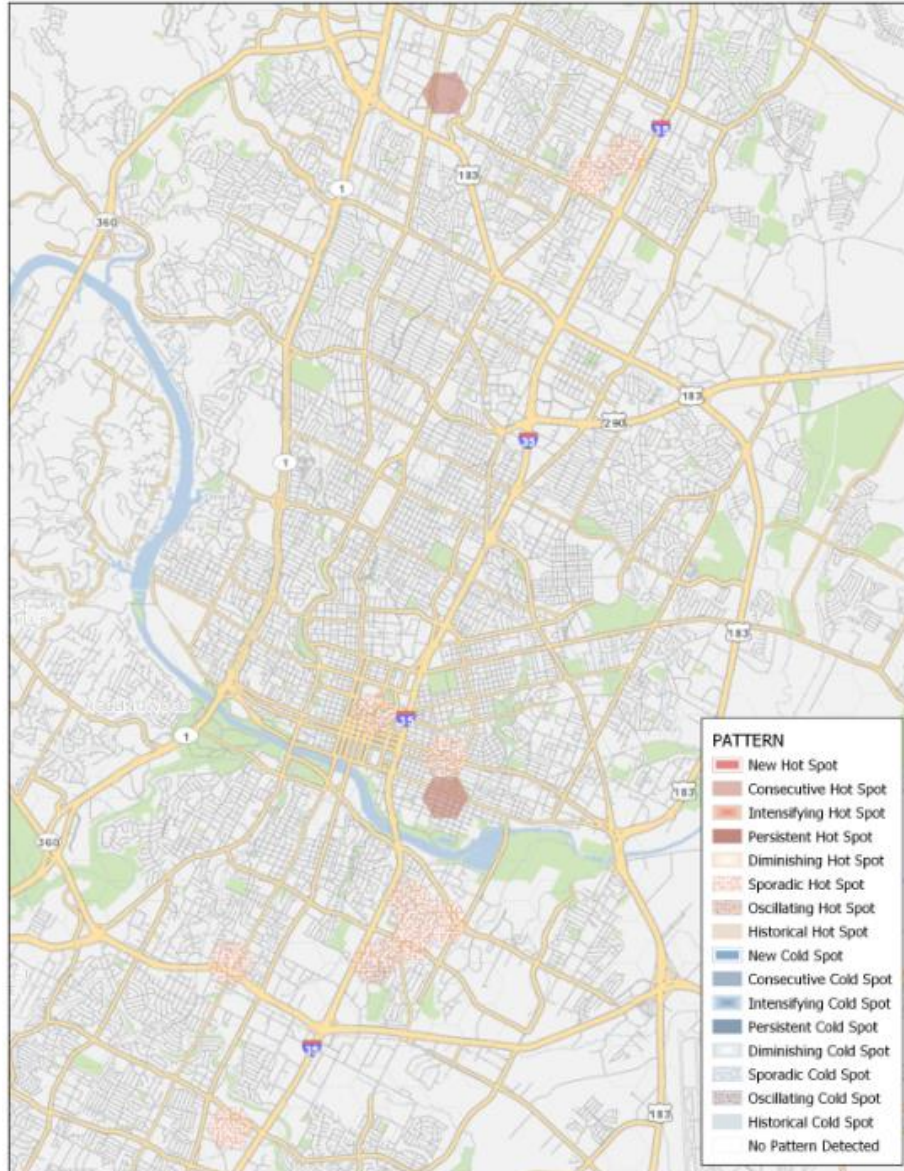




Historical Auto Theft Rates and 2018 Locations



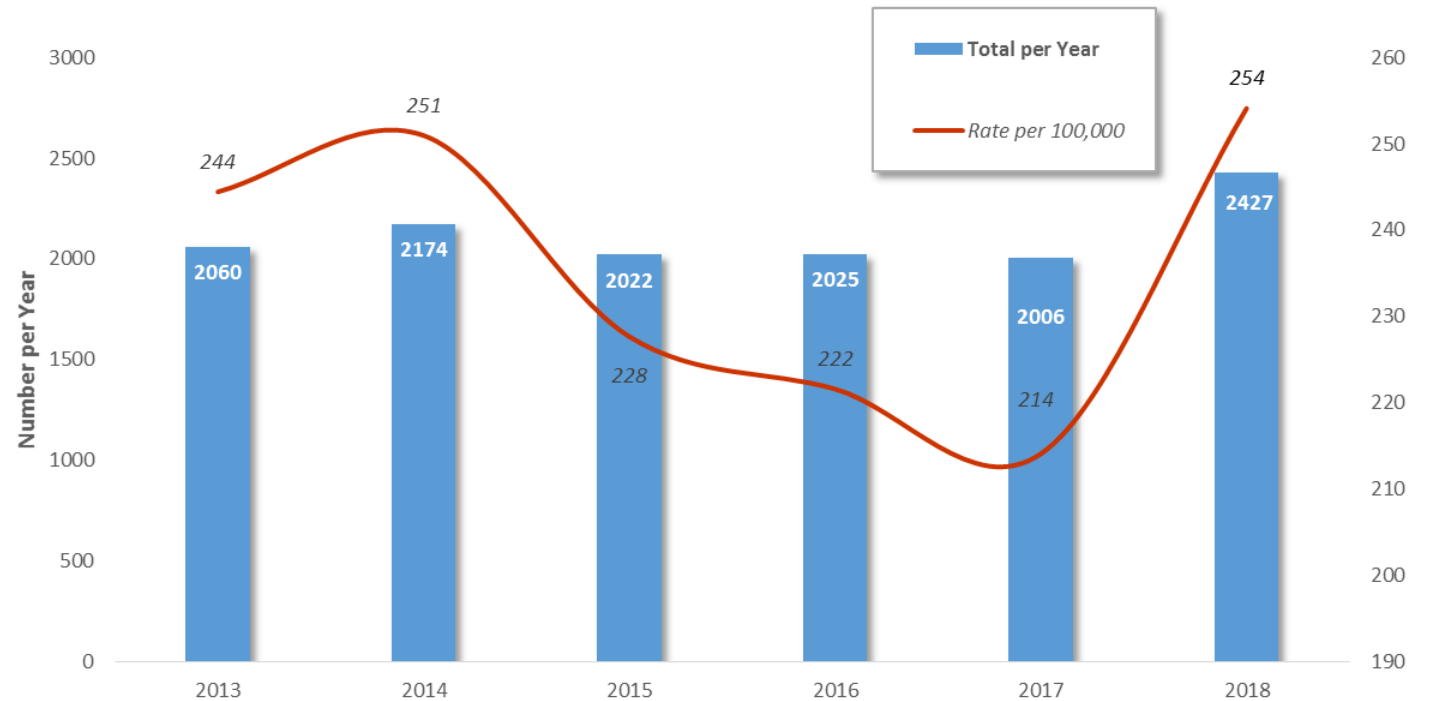
Auto Theft Hotspots 2018



Summary

- 2018 auto thefts were the highest in the past six years, up 21% from 2017 and 18% from five-year average (2013-2017)
- Beginning mid-year, 2018 auto thefts outpaced previous five years
- 2018 experienced first significant per capita increase since 2015
- 2018 case clearances 2% above the 5-year average of 15 percent

Total per Year & Rate per Capita

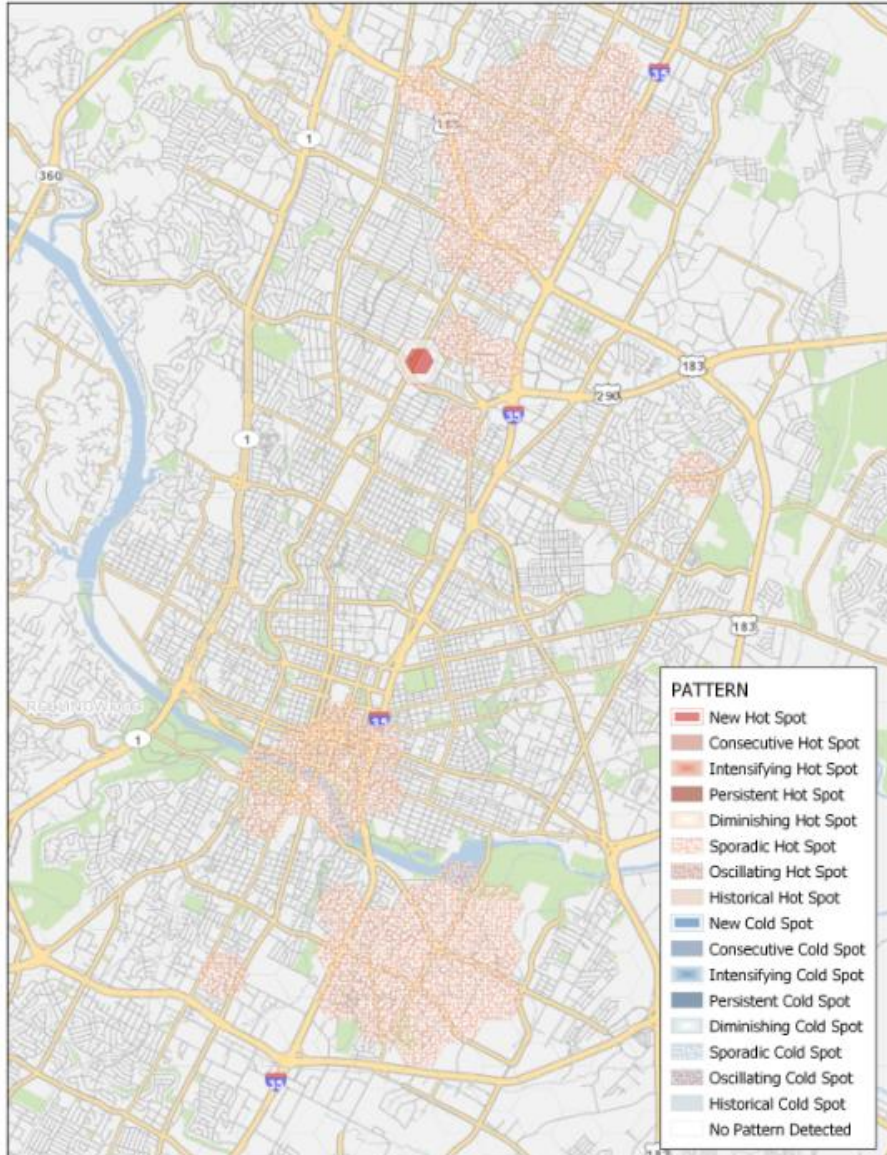




Historical Burglary Rates and 2018 Locations

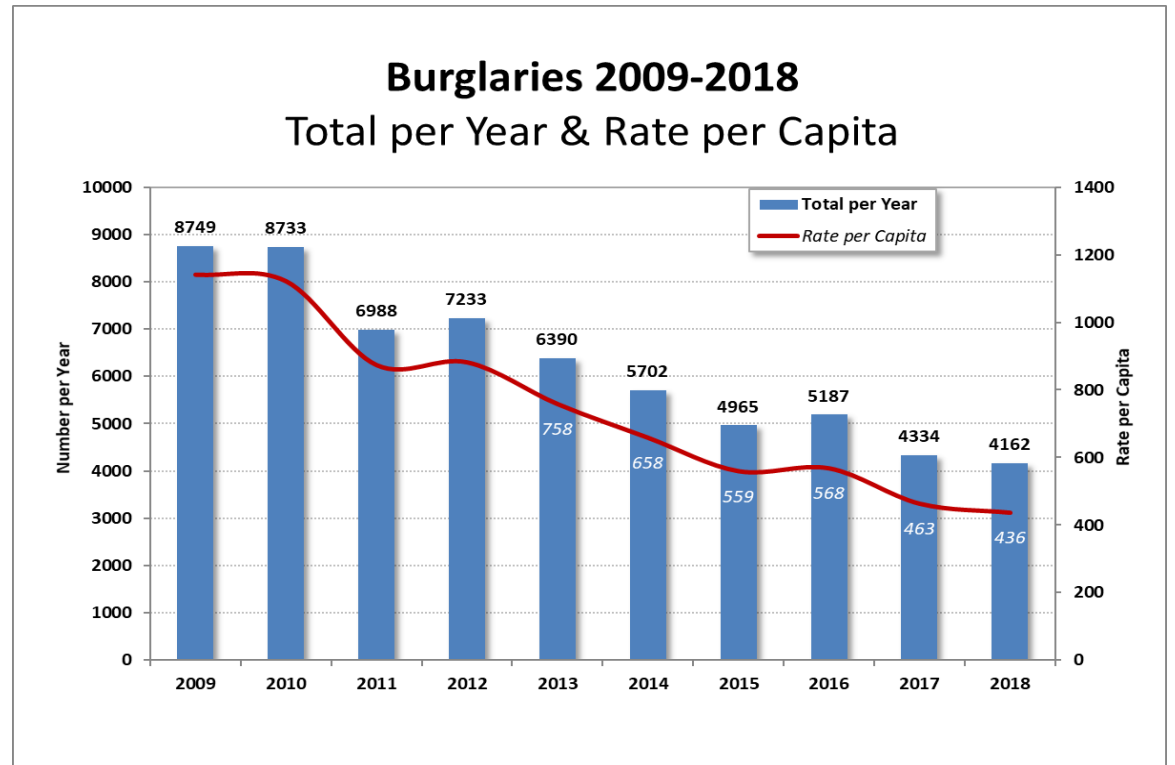


All Burglaries 2018



Summary

- 2018 Burglaries were down 4% compared to 2017, and down 52% from the ten-year high in 2009.
- Residential burglaries were down 10% compared to 2017, and down 66% from the ten-year high in 2010.
- Non-residential burglaries were up 5% compared to 2017, but still down 16% from the ten-year high in 2009.



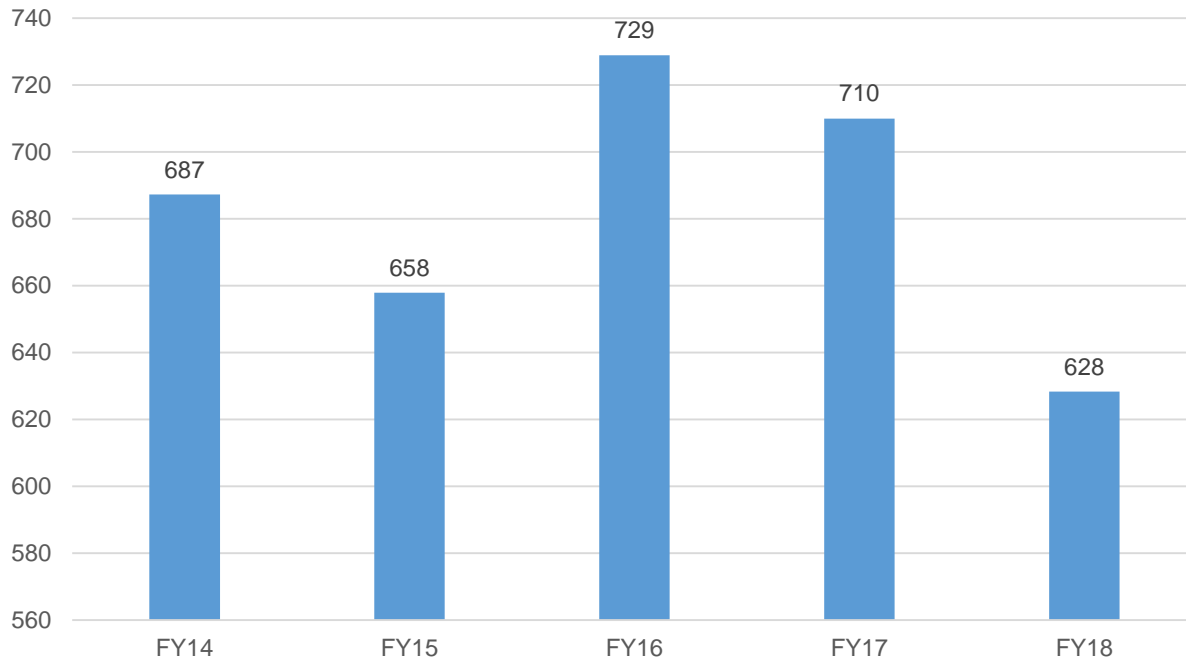

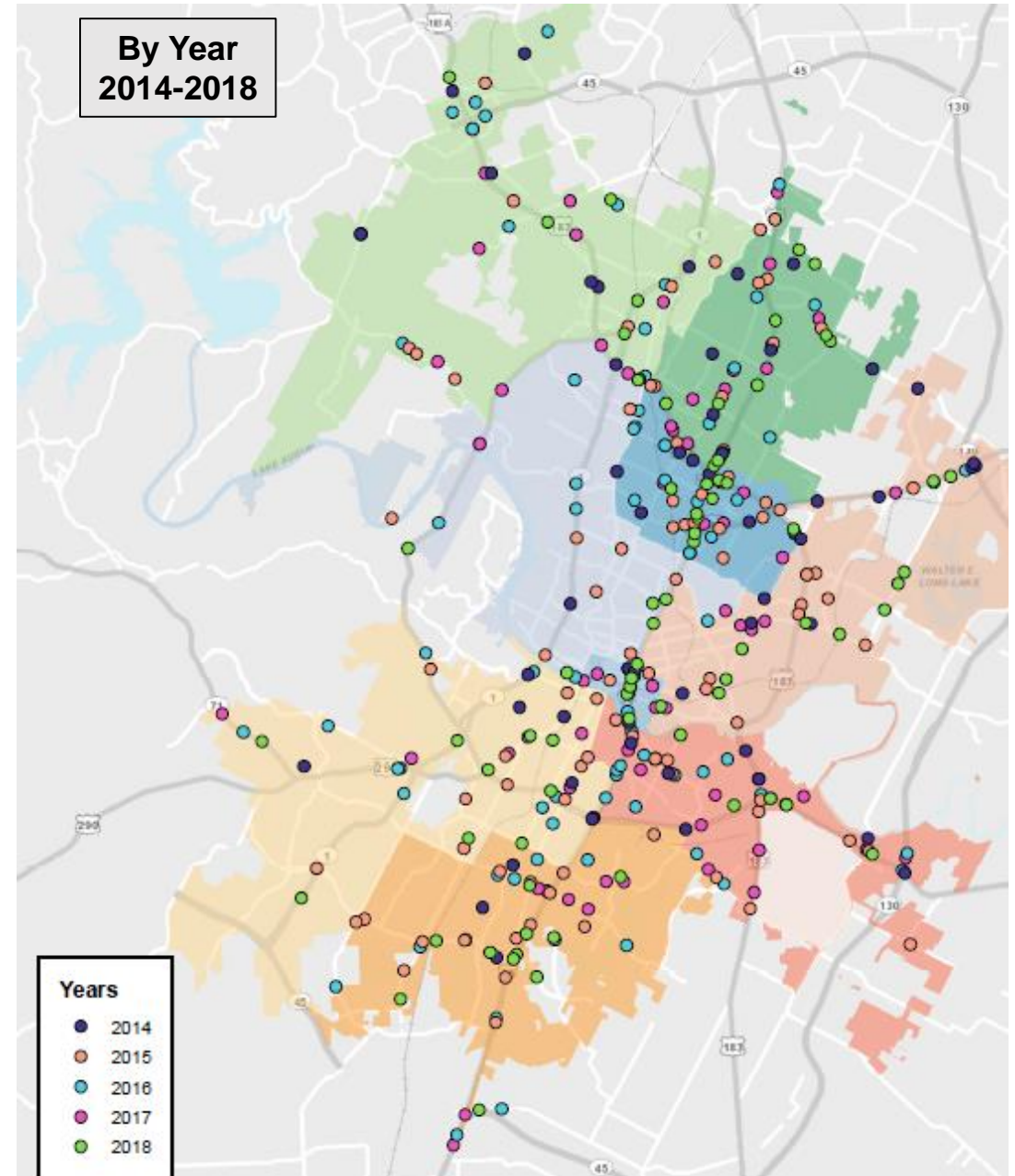

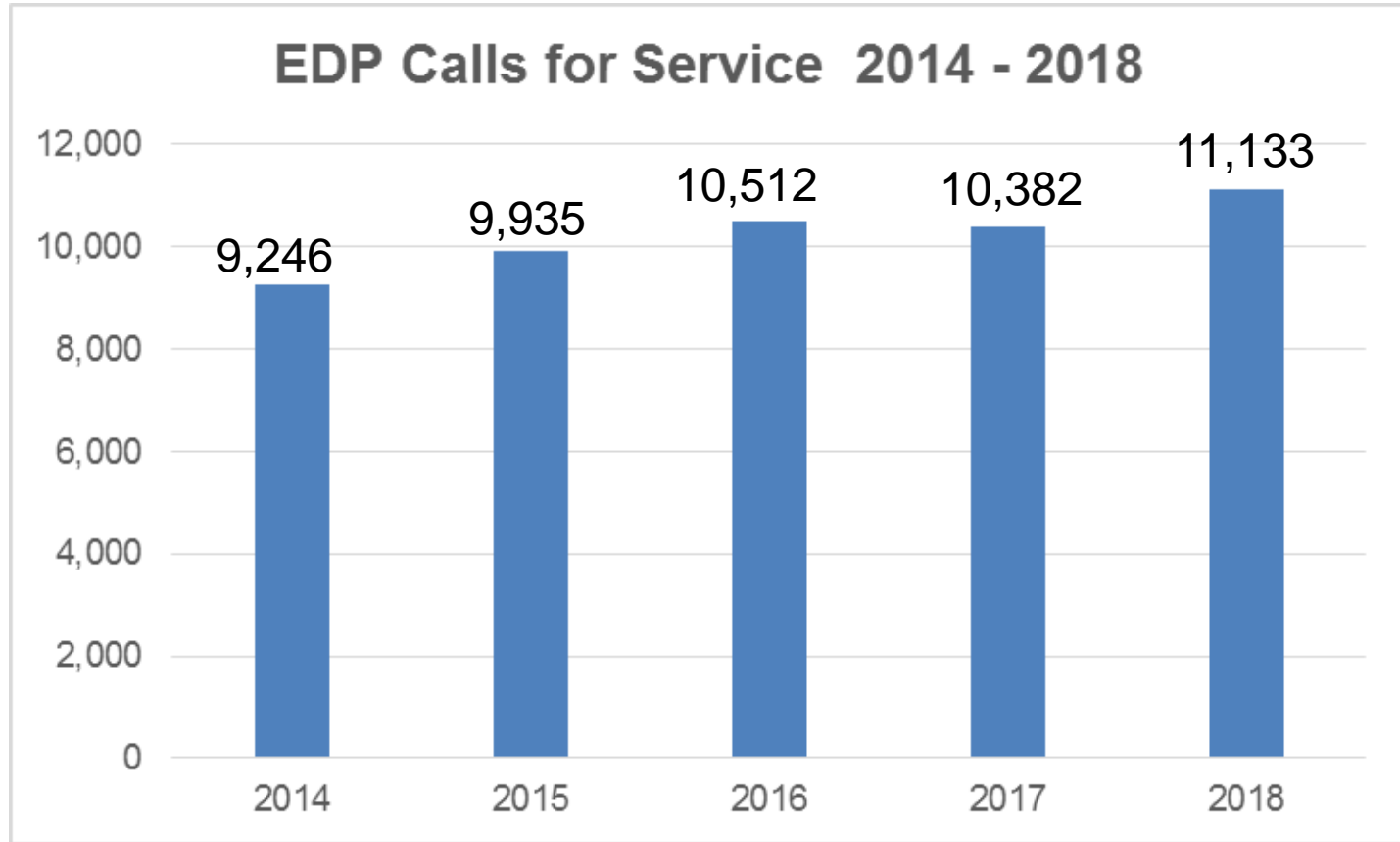
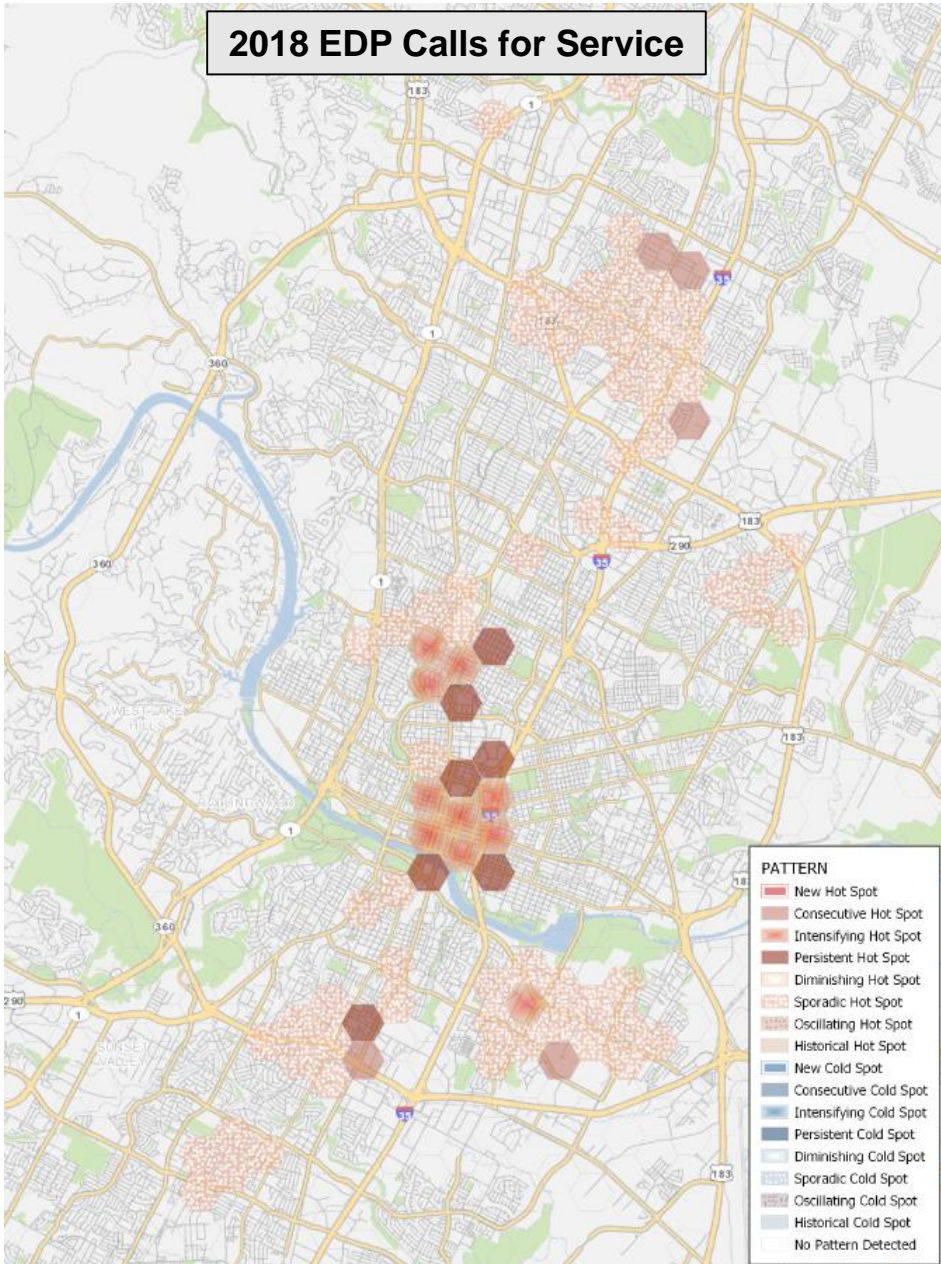


2014 - 2018 Traffic Fatalities
